

Campaign Overview

Jerri Green is the Democratic nominee for Governor of Tennessee, running to lower costs and raise wages, expand healthcare access, and fully fund public schools. We are building a historic, people-powered movement to take back Tennessee for everyday people and families—not billionaires.

To achieve this vision, our campaign is hiring energetic, community-oriented individuals to engage directly with voters across the state.

Position Breakdown & Core Responsibilities

Door-Knocking Canvassers (In-Person)

- **Voter Contact:** Conduct in-person, door-to-door canvassing in targeted Tennessee neighborhoods to speak directly with voters about the campaign and economic or social issues impacting their communities.
- **Data Collection:** Correctly and completely track data and voter feedback from doorstep conversations using the campaign's mobile tracking software.
- **Education:** Engage community members in meaningful conversations about Jerri Green's plans to lower costs, protect public education, and expand healthcare.

Position Requirements & Expectations

For Canvassers:

- **Location:** Must either live in or be able to easily travel to shifts within one of the following Tennessee counties: Shelby, Davidson, Knox, Hamilton, Wilson, Williamson, Rutherford, Sumner, or Montgomery.
- **Commitment & Performance:** Must complete at least four 3-hour shifts per week and maintain a pace to knock on at least 400 doors per week.
- **Mobility:** Must be able to walk and stand for long periods of time.
- **Travel:** Valid driver's license and access to reliable transportation are required.
- **Age Requirement:** Applicants must be 18 years of age or older.

For Canvassing Leads:

- **Location:** Must either live in or be able to easily travel to shifts within one of the following Tennessee counties: Shelby, Davidson, Knox, Hamilton, Wilson, Williamson, Rutherford, Sumner, or Montgomery.
- **Leading Regular Canvasses:** Launch local canvasses, distribute turf packets/materials, and provide hands-on training for new canvassers.

- **Recruitment of Volunteers:** Conduct active outreach via phone, text, and community networking to recruit, schedule, and retain local volunteers to expand campaign capacity.
- **Commitment & Performance:** Must complete at least three 3-hour shifts per week and maintain a pace to knock on at least 300 doors per week.
- **Mobility:** Must be able to walk and stand for long periods of time.
- **Travel:** Valid driver's license and access to reliable transportation are required.
- **Age Requirement:** Applicants must be 18 years of age or older.

General Skills:

- Strong alignment with Jerri Green's campaign mission, vision, and core values.
- Ability to quickly learn and effectively communicate talking points regarding key campaign issues.
- Prior canvassing, phone banking, or customer service experience is a plus, but comprehensive training will be provided.

- Canvasser Pay: \$20 per hour.
- Canvasser Lead Pay: \$25 per hour

 - Weekdays: 4:00 PM – 8:00 PM CST
 - Saturdays: 10:00 AM – 6:00 PM CST
 - Sundays: 2:00 PM – 6:00 PM CST

Diversity & Application Process
